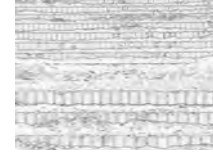

Josephine Evetts-Secker, MDiv

Josephine Evetts-Secker, Jungian analyst, completed her training at the C.G. Jung Institute Zurich in 1988. She lectures regularly at ISAP and serves on the training board of the London Independent Group of Analytical Psychologists (IGAP). Her lecture series, to be published as a book by Spring, will explore the language of analytical discourse (and other related discourses) from a grammatical perspective, concentrating on ways in which psychological transformation is effected linguistically. Archetypal energies are active in grammatical structures, particularly those that underlie neglected aspects of our speech and unchanging word forms. Imagine Jung's psychology without the preposition between (*zwischen*), or the Latin affix *trans*, or the ubiquitous *über*. These lectures will reflect on the archetypal undertow constantly at work in our discourse about psychology, in therapeutic dialogues, in our narratives from psyche's lived experience, in dreams, fairy tales and myths, seeing specific linguistic forms as a language for the soul.

Peter Ammann is a founding member of ISAP, where he is also a lecturer, training analyst and supervisor. After training as a cellist he entered the C.G. Jung Institute Zurich. He completed analytic training in 1965, encouraged by Jung himself as well as by his analysts, Jolande Jacobi and Marie Louise von Franz. Soon pursuing his dream of becoming a filmmaker, he apprenticed with Federico Fellini for the making of *Satyricon*. His 1984 encounter with Laurens van der Post inspired his enduring interests in Africa, traditional healing, and the integration of a Jungian perspective in his documentary films.
