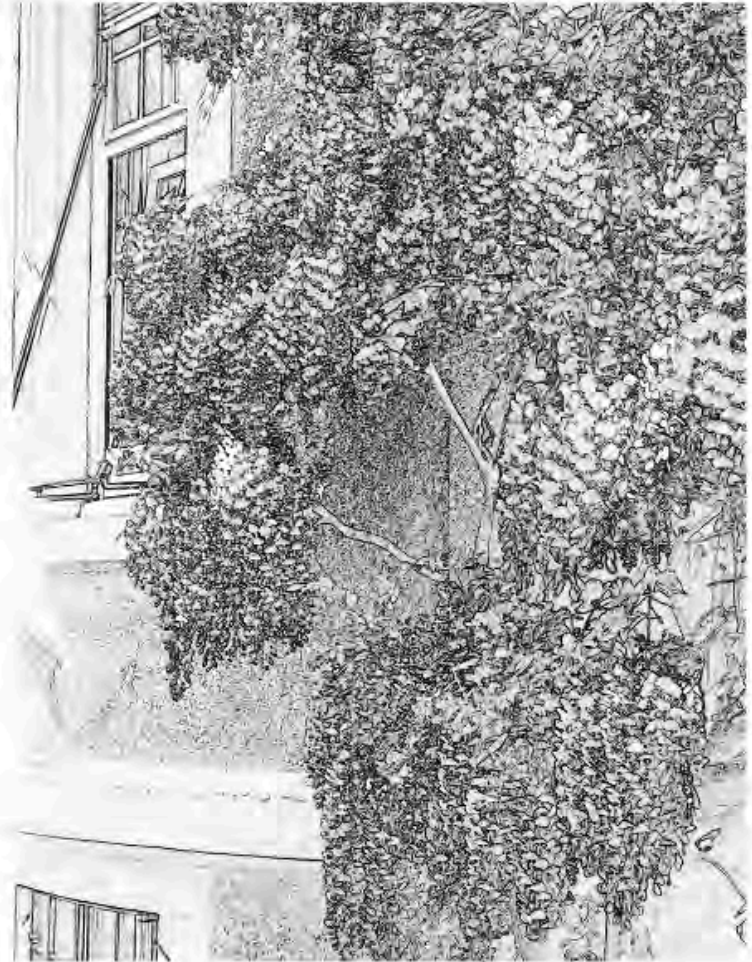

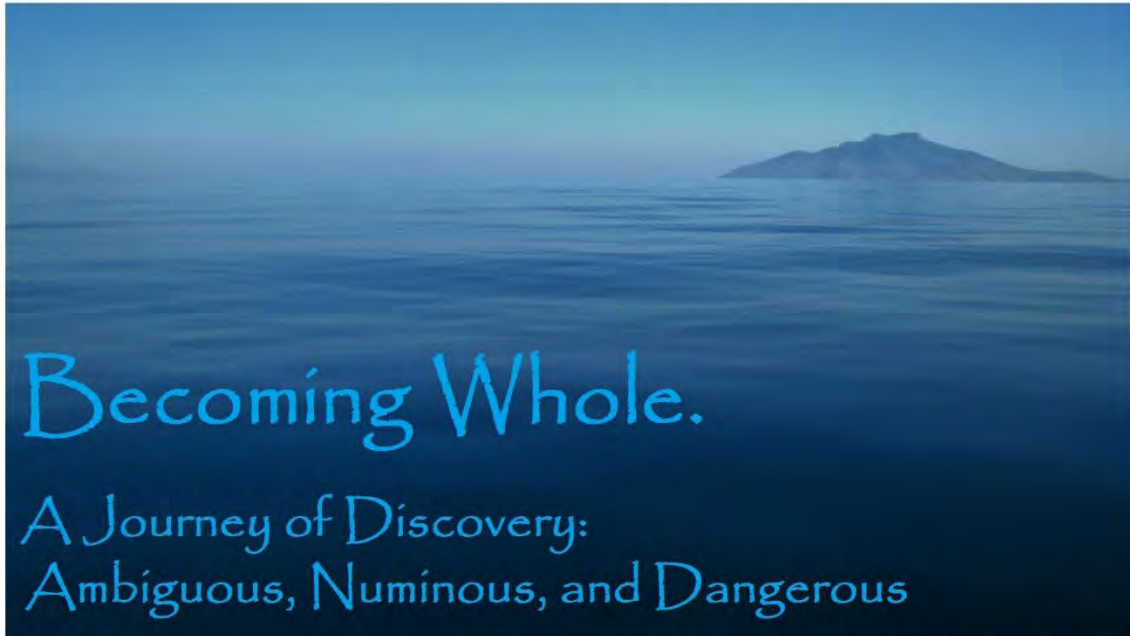

Jung and Erich Neumann (Philemon Series, 2015).

Eleonóra Babejová, PhD is a writer and a Jungian analyst trained at ISAP Zurich. She has a psychotherapeutic practice in Zug and Zurich and works at the ISAP library. She was awarded her PhD from the University of Cambridge in historical geography and has worked as a teacher, research scholar and a translator.
