By registering for the Jungian Odyssey, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

The variety of packages for the Jungian Odyssey includes the programs, services, and conditions described at www.jungianodyssey.com, in our downloadable brochure, and in our online registration form. In addition, you agree to this Personal Privacy clause:

Personal Privacy You agree to our publication of photos that may be taken of you by our appointed photographer(s) during the Odyssey. We store and publish these photos—always without names or other identifying information—in our publicly accessible **online archive**. The photos are downloadable, and may be used for ISAPZURICH's general marketing purposes. Objections must be sent to: info@jungianodyssey.com

Further:

- (1) Odyssey enrollment is limited and granted on a first-come-first-serve basis. Your place at the Odyssey will be confirmed upon our receipt of your registration form and paid fees.
- (2) In conjunction with your completion of our online registration form, you are asked to rank your choices for seminars and workshops. We will do our best to grant your top choices, as space allows. You will be notified about your course placements upon arrival at the Odyssey.
- (3) The rule of confidentiality applies for our Temenos and all seminars and workshops that deal with sensitive material. For the protection of personal boundaries, experiential workshops are excluded for analysts of ISAPZURICH and all others (including trainees) who anticipate or encounter their analysands, patients, or supervisees at these events.
- (4) The daily program may be subject to change, within limits.
- (5) ISAPZURICH-AGAP (hereafter ISAP) is unable to provide discounts or refunds for your partial use of program events and services that are included in Odyssey packages.
- (6) **Force Majeure** Insofar as a public health crisis and/or other catastrophic events may influence travel conditions, it is your responsibility to monitor and comply with all applicable rules. They may vary from country to country *and* depend on the country from which you enter Switzerland. Should such a situation arise *within Switzerland*, we will inform you about the consitions as soon as possible in advance of the Odyssey. See also point (7) below:

(7) Cancellation & Refunds

If you cancel your registration in due time, we will refund your payment minus a fee to cover ISAP's incurred administrative costs, banking or credit card fees, and eventual hotel cancellation fees. You qualify for a refund according to the following cancellation dates:

- by March 15: refund 95% of your paid fees
- by April 5: refund 50% of your paid fees
- after April 5: forfeit of all refunds

Force Majeure ISAP itself reserves the right to cancel the Jungian Odyssey due to underenrollment, a public health crisis, or other catastrophic events. In such a case we will notify you as soon as possible and credit 100% of your paid fees toward a future Odyssey—or refund 98% of your paid fees. (The deducted 2% covers only our incurred banking or credit card fees.)

(8) **Wireless LAN** is available throughout the premises (at no cost); *however, the service is limited to 6:30 AM – 11:30 PM*.

(9) Waiver of Liability

It is your responsibility to have insurance that covers costs incurred by delayed or cancelled flights, trains, etc., as well as costs incurred by your cancellation or withdrawal due to illness or injury occurring prior to or during the Odyssey. For all such cases, ISAP declines all liability.
