## The Psychological Club

The castle-like clubhouse, a stately neo-Gothic villa, was once referred to as a place where the holy fire, le feu sacré, burns. The Club was founded in 1916, and was a forum for Carl Jung's ideas. Besides a guided tour of the premises, e.g. the unique library, we will hear a lecture by Ursula Kiraly-Müller about the foundation and development of the club, with special emphasis on the club as Jung's research field and "Human Experiment", where he could test his discoveries and theories on himself and the club members. The club was therefore also a "group process", often involving delicate challenges. It was far from certain that this experiment would succeed.
