Presented by ISAP's veteran theater troupe, this play dramatizes a historic meeting between Prof. C.G. Jung and Rabbi Leo Baeck at the Zurich Hotel Savoy Baur en Ville in October 1946. Beginning as a tense stand-off between the two men, both giants in their respective fields, the encounter unfolds into a dialogue in which they exchange the grim reality of the events that caught them up in the years preceding and during the second world war. A mysterious feminine figure guides them through the process of confrontation and reconciliation.
