

Need-Based Grant Request • Instructions • Odyssey 2020

Crucial Points to Consider

- For the Odyssey 2020, an anonymous donor contributed a total of CHF 5000.00, stipulated for use as grant funds for US Americans only. Individual grant awards are limited and *need-based*—i.e. they are not based on US citizenship alone. As a rule, students of ISAPZÜRICH may not apply for grants under this program.
- Depending on the number of applicants, the grant amounts vary. Typically, they range between CHF 500.00 and CHF 1000.00 per person. The awards are not disbursed to recipients but credited toward their Jungian Odyssey fees.
- Priority is given to applicants who establish the need for financial support. It is assumed that, without financial support, attendance of the Odyssey would be impossible.
- If the number of applicants exceeds the available funds, we are, unfortunately, forced to decline some requests (no matter how eligible they may be). In such a case, eligible requests will be approved on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- *Please do not register for the Odyssey or pay the fee until we inform you about the outcome of your request.* If you are granted a credit, we will instruct you about the registration procedure and how to deduct the amount from the regular registration fee.
- You may submit your letter of request at any time before or by **February 1st**. At or shortly after that deadline, our committee begins to consider requests. We inform applicants about the results **by March 1st, at latest**.

Letter of Request • Materials Due by February 1st

- Your name, date of birth, current postal address, and education thus far
- Statement of US citizenship, and a copy of the identifying page of your currently valid US passport
- Statement of your personal and/or professional interest in the Jungian Odyssey
- Declaration of need (e.g. student status, low income, other hardship)
- Statement as to your previous receipt of support funds from us and if so, how much, and in which year(s)
- Any other information that you would like us to consider
